Also these students are less likely to drop out of school, carry weapons, use drugs or engage in other high-risk behaviors and they have better relationships with family and friends. “The Career Mentoring Program will enable us to help our teenage participants form a bond with successful business leaders and executives,” said Marshall.

Marshall is currently the associate producer and air personality on the nationally syndicated Neal Boortz Show, which is heard in over 200 cities across America. He was also the host of “The Royal Treatment”, a talk show that ran for 9 years on WSB. Royal is a deacon at the Ray of Hope Christian Church. He is a 1992 graduate of the University of Georgia.
