Impacting the World

Foreverfamily works to ensure that, no matter what the circumstances, all children have the opportunity to be surrounded by the love of family. It focuses its efforts on some of the most marginalized children in our society—those with an incarcerated parent or parents. Foreverfamily also aims to support them as they, their parents, caregivers and extended families work to remain a family. Over the past 12 months, in-depth qualitative data have been collected from former AIM and Foreverfamily participants who graciously shared their firsthand accounts of experiences with the organization and the ways in which they were impacted by them. These narratives and the meanings ascribed to them are presented in the 2021 brief. Following is a sample quote that serves to highlight Foreverfamily's enduring legacy on those it served. In it, the participant expresses gratitude for having the opportunity to maintain a connection to loved ones and reflects on the most memorable aspects of the Family Visitation Program.

“I remember our little packed lunches and the snacks they gave us on the bus. And the most memorable thing I'll say is, my sister's face and my nieces' face when they saw one another. ‘Til this day, that image is very clear in my mind. I don't remember the sound of slamming doors or having to be searched, or any of those things that they say are traumatic for children going into prison.”

Foreverlearners was a year long virtual program that took 15 children, each semester, on a 12 week course of study to assist them with homework, e-coaching and teach them study skills.
